

PARIS.....U.S. Defense Secretary Robert McNamara announced here Sunday he will offer America's Allies a plan for a NATO Common Market in defense production. McNamara disclosed the plan at Orly Airport when he flew in for a two day meeting of NATO Defense Ministers opening here tomorrow afternoon.

MOSCOW.....A Soviet Communist newspaper Sunday said an American Pilot captured by the Communist North Vietnamese was only telling them "Things which might please us." Capt Philip Butler of Oklahoma and Lemore, California, was said to have been shot down over North Viet Nam April 20.

JOHNSON CITY, TEXAS.....President Johnson is spending the Holiday weekend at his ranch near Johnson City. The President visited his boyhood home, went for a boat ride and paid tribute to the late John F Kennedy Saturday. Kennedy would have been 48 years old Saturday.

WASHINGTON.....A repair ship is steaming to the site of an underwater cable break which threatened to delay the four day Gemini Space Shot scheduled for Thursday.

JAKARTA.....Foreign Minister Subandrio returned from a meeting with Communist Chinese Premier Chow En-Lai Saturday night and said talks went well "Dispite the attempts of others to undermine the conference of Afro-Asian Nations in Algiers next month."

NORTHFIELD, MINNESOTA.....Vice President Hubert Humphrey said Sunday that only education can prevent technology from becoming the master of man.

OKLAHOMA CITY.....Eleven firemen were hospitalized with injuries while fighting a fire in downtown Oklahoma City Sunday morning. Some of them were nearly buried when the front of a blazing restaurant collapsed.

LONDON.....Prime Minister Harold Wilson met with his top economic advisers Sunday against a background of mounting public hostility and an opposition campaign to topple his Labor Government.

WASHINGTON.....Henry Cabot Lodge, former Ambassador to South Viet Nam said Sunday is was unlikely the war in that Asian Country would end by negotiations.

MONTGOMERY, ALABAMA.....Former Alabama Governor Gordon Persons died Saturday night at Saint Margarets Hospital. Person's was Governor from 1951-1955.

COURTLAND, NEW YORK.....Westchester County, New York, Officials are investigating the case of a 59 year old man who died after a 24 hour hunger strike while in custody. Henry Dressers death Thursday was attributed officially to a heart attack. His wife claims he starved himself because he considered a five dollar fine for a minor traffic violation unjust. He chose to go to jail rather than pay the fine.

CAIRO..... A five day conference Sunday divided over how to defend their Nation against possible Israeli attack. Israel has confronted them with the most serious Military threat since 1956.

UPPER SANDUSKY, OHIO.....Five person's including three teenagers were killed and one person was critically injured in a two car crash near Upper Sandusky early Sunday morning. State Police said the driver of one car ran a stop sign and rammed another car.
