BY UNITED PRESS INTERNATIONAL.....HEAVY WEIGHT CHAMPION CASSIUS CLAY IS HEADING FOR NEW YORK WITH A STOP OVER IN MASSACHUSETTS AND VANQUISHED SONNY LISTON IS BACK IN DENVER. CLAY RETAINED HIS TITLE AT LEWISTON, MAINE TUESDAY NIGHT BY KNOCKING OUT LISTON IN THE FIRST ROUND. LISTON RETURNED TO DENVER A DAY AFTER SCHEDULED WEDNESDAY NIGHT AND CLAIMED HE GOT A "FAST SHUFFLE" HE DID NOT ELABORATE BUT PLANS TO KEEP ON FIGHTING.
