"The race will be all Ford Engines, unless another automobile manufacturer decides to get in. The tab is getting too high for an individual to stay in the running," said the President of Meyer and Drake.

NEW YORK....National Football League Commissioner, Pete Rozelle, announced yesterday he had recommended the addition of two teams to expand the league to 16 teams by 1967. Moments later, Commissioner Joe Foss of the rival American Football League said his circuit could name and field two more teams by 1966, if he wants to.

CHICAGO.....Craig Breedlove, builder of the three wheeled Spirit of America and one time world land speed record holder, announced yesterday he would build another jet car and try to reclaim the record he lost. Last year, Breedlove and his three wheeled car twice broke the world land speed record. In his last effort, he drove the car to a speed of 526 MPH. Shortly thereafter, Art Arfons upped the record to 537MPH in his Green Monster and that speed now stands as the record.
