SAIGON.....U.S. WARSHIPS HAVE GONE INTO ACTION AGAINST THE COMMUNISTS IN NORTH VIET NAM FOR THE FIRST TIME, A SPOKESMAN DISCLOSED THURSDAY. AMERICAN DESTROYERS BOMBARDED TROOP CONCENTRATIONS IN THREE PROVINCES.

CHICAGO.....DEMONSTRATORS CRASHED THROUGH POLICE BARRICADES AND TRIED TO SHOVE THEIR WAY INTO THE BUILDING WHERE HEARINGS OF THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON UNAMERICAN ACTIVITIES WERE IN PROGRESS THURSDAY. POLICE BEAT THEM BACK, WHEN DEMONSTRATORS LAY DOWN ON THE SIDEWALK AND BEGAN SINGING, "WE SHALL OVERCOME." THEY WERE PICKED UP AND LOWERED INTO PADDY WAGONS. POLICE ESTIMATED A TOTAL OF 35 PERSONS, MOSTLY WHITE AND NEGRO TEENAGERS, WERE ARRESTED. THIRTY (30) PERSONS WERE ARRESTED IN TWO PREVIOUS STORMY SESSIONS OF THE COMMITTEE'S INVESTIGATION OF ALLEGED COMMUNIST ACTIVITIES IN THE CHICAGO AREA. ONE OF THURSDAYS DEMONSTRATORS WAS BEATEN TO HIS KNEES WHEN HE TRIED TO FORCE HIS WAY INTO THE OLD U.S. CIRCUIT COURT OF APPEALS BUILDING WHERE THE HEARINGS WERE IN PROGRESS. INSIDE THE COMMITTEE ROOM, TWO WITNESS'S INVOKED THE FIFTH AMMENDMENT REPEATEDLY, REPEATEDLY, REFUSING TO GIVE THEIR AGES OR PLACES OF BIRTH.

SANTO DOMINGO.....INCREASINGLY BITTER INTERNAL RELATIONS CONTINUED THURSDAY TO BLOCK OUTSIDE EFFORTS IN THE DOMINICAN CIVIL WAR. CRITICISM OF THE FOREIGN ROLE IN PEACEMAKING EFFORTS MOUNTED IN BOTH CAMPS OF THE REBEL MILITARY DOMINICAN FACTIONS.

LA PAZ, BOLIVIA.....TERRORIST BOMBS ROCKED LA PAZ SUBURBS THURSDAY AS REBEL FIGHTING WAS REPORTED IN THE ANDES MOUNTAIN PLATEAU BETWEEN REBEL TIN MINERS AND JUNTA TROOPS. THE BOMBINGS HERE ACCOMPANIED BY SHARP GUNFIRE APPEARED TO HAVE SHATTERED A CEASE FIRE REACHED EARLIER THIS WEEK BETWEEN THE MILITARY JUNTA AND REVOLUTION BENT REBEL UNIONISTS. CHARGES OF DYNAMITE EXPLODED IN AT LEAST FOUR LA PAZ SUBURBS. DYNAMITE IS THE TIN MINERS FAVORITE WEAPON. THERE WAS NO IMMEDIATE REPORT ON CASUALTIES IN THE CAPITAL. AT LEAST 70 PERSONS WERE KILLED AND 250 WOUNDED IN FIGHTING EARLIER THIS WEEK. THE NEW OUT-BREAK OF VIOLENCE CAME ONLY HOURS AFTER ARMY CHIEF OF STAFF, MAJOR GENERAL ALFREDO OVANDO WAS SWORN IN AS "CO PRESIDENT" OF THE MILITARY JUNTA GOVERNMENT.

SAIGON.....A NAVY JET WAS SHOT DOWN OVER NORTH VIET NAM THURSDAY AND THE PILOT PRESUMEDLY KILLED, A SPOKESMAN FOR U.S. MILITARY HEAD-QUARTERS REPORTED. TWO OTHER AMERICANS WERE KILLED WEDNESDAY IN GROUND FIGHTING IN SOUTH VIET NAM.

SINGAPORE.....PATROL BOATS GUARDING MALAYSIA SHOT UP AN INDONESIAN FIGHTING BOAT WEDNESDAY NIGHT, PROBABLY KILLING THREE SABOTEURS, IT WAS ANNOUNCED THURSDAY.

WASHINGTON.....SECRETARY OF STATE DEAN RUSK HAS SERVED NOTICE ON RUSSIA AND RED CHINA THAT THE UNITED STATES WILL NOT BE FRIGHTENED OUT OF VIET NAM BY THREATS OF A WAR IN ASIA.
